Requirements:

There are no academic requirements for new students enrolling in the General English course. To place students in the appropriate class, they are required to sit a Placement Test during orientation or induction. Alternatively, students can be placed based on their previous General English summative test results.

International students must:

- Be at least 18 years of age and have completed the equivalent of Year 12.

- Participate in a course entry interview to determine suitability for the course and student needs.

Assessment Method:

In the General English program, assessments are designed to track progress in the core language skills—speaking, listening, reading, and writing—across all proficiency levels. Formative assessments are taken every week. Summative assessments are completed by week 5 and week 10.

1. Beginner to Intermediate Levels:

Students are evaluated through a mix of quizzes, in-class participation, listening and speaking activities, as well as vocabulary and grammar exercises. Regular progress tests help monitor improvement in basic communication skills and language comprehension.

2. Upper-Intermediate to Advanced Levels:

Assessments become more comprehensive and may include written essays, presentations, group discussions, and language proficiency tests. At advanced levels, students are encouraged to demonstrate fluency and accuracy through real-world scenarios and more complex language tasks.

Feedback is provided after each assessment to guide further development, and overall progress is continuously monitored through interactive learning activities and formal evaluations.

Pathways:

Upon successfully completing a level, you will progress to the next level of the course. Students who are following an academic pathway will be eligible to transition into further courses once they achieve the Advanced level in the General English program.
